Be it known that on this Eighteenth day of July One thousand eight hundred and Seventy nine, Before me, Maurice T. Otero, a Notary Public, in and for the City and Parish of New Orleans, State of Louisiana aforesaid, duly Commissioned and sworn personally came and appeared

Messrs Agostino Marzola, John Bertucci Felice Bellucci, Francisco Liccardi, Lorenzo Ingargola, Fedele Baraco, Joseph Bertucci and Michele Venuto, all of the full age of majority and residents of this city, as the truth respectively declare

Who severally declared that availing themselves of the provisions of the laws of the State of Louisiana, relative to the organization of Corporations for Literary, Scientific, Religious & Charitable purposes, they have covenanted and contracted and by these presents do covenant contract and bind themselves, and those who may hereafter be associated with them to form themselves into and constitute a Corporation, for the objects and purposes, and under the stipulations and regulations following to wit:

Article First

The objects and purposes of this association are hereby declared to be the uniting of Italians, from Ustica in Italy, and residents of this city, into a brotherhood and society, wherein the members thereof shall find relief and assistance in case of need, and wherein said members shall exercise towards one another benevolence and charity

Article Second

The name, style and title of this Corporation shall be the "Congregazione di San-Bartholomeo Apostolo" ("Congregation of St. Bartholomew, the Apostle")

Article Third

The place chosen for its domicile is the City of New-Orleans, in the State of Louisiana

Article Fourth

The association shall have a President a Vice

Who shall be elected at a general meeting of the Association held for that purpose on the first Monday in January in each year. The duties of such officers, as well as of all subordinate officers of said Association shall be determined in the Constitution and By-Laws of this Society.

Article Fifth

The President of this Association shall be the proper officer in whom all Citations may be served

Article Sixth

The said Association shall exist and continue for the space of twenty five years

Article Seventh

The following are hereby declared to be the officers of this Association, whose term of office shall expire on the 1st Monday in January 1880, to wit: Agostino Marzola, President; John Bertucci, Vice President; Francesco Licardi, Treasurer; Felice Bertucci, Secretary; Lorenzo Ingargiola, Grand Marshal and Vincenzo Mascari, Salvatore Pusimone, Fedele Baraso & Giuseppe Pione, members of the Finance Committee
